A Revelation of the Day of Jehovah Tsaba

Seven Talking Points

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1. Who is Jehovah Tsaba? Psalmist David's Introduction of Him & Isaiah's Prophecy of a Special End-Time Event Called, The Day of Jehovah Tsaba (Lord of hosts)
 - A. He is the King of Glory, the Lord Strong Mighty in Battle – Ps. 24:8-10
 - B. The Only Jehovah Name for Which a Prophetic Event is Named – Is. 2:10-12
 - C. The New Testament References Only this One Jehovah Name – James 5:4
 - D. Jehovah Tsaba, King of Glory-His Glory Fills the Whole Earth – Is. 6:3
2. Isaiah's Announces A Special Day of God's Glory Given in this Age to the Church
 - A. When Darkness Covers the Earth, His Glory is Seen Upon Us – Is. 60:1-3,9
 - B. A Time of Special Favor & Comfort for God's People –Ps. 102:13 & Is. 61:3
3. Isaiah's Prophetic Description of The Glory & Splendor of the World Given to the Church
 - A. Haggai & Zechariah (Called Twin Prophets Because They Traveled & Prophesied Together, eg. Ezra 5:1; 6:14) Both Announce a Greater Event Than the Deliverance of Israel from Egypt & Shaking of All the Nations to

- Bring God's Created Glory (Gold & Silver) to His People – Hag. 2:5-9 & Zech. 2:8-10
- B. Riches & Wealth of Nations & World's Goods Prophesied to Overwhelm Us with Blessings – Is. 60:3-11
 - C. We are Called Ministers & Priests of God & World's Wealth Converted to Us – Is. 61:6,9
4. Luke's Gospel Where Jesus Closed the Book & The Prophecy of James, Chapter Five – Both Depicting A vengeance to Comfort (Fallacy of World's fraudulent Wage/Money System, God's Divine Judgment upon it & a Subsequent Wealth Conversion to the Church)
- A. Jesus Closed the Book in the Middle of the Sentence, Just Prior to a Conjunction to Declare a Special Fulfillment of Scripture – Luke 4:19-21
 - B. Following the Conjunction there was a special "Vengeance to Comfort & Wealth Conversion." Is. 61:2-9
 - C. On Two Other Occasions Isaiah Confirms a World-Wide Prophetic Event – Is. 14:24,26 & Is. 23:1-9
 - D. The Prophecy of James Speaks of the Same Vengeance to Comfort – James 5:1-4
5. You Will Not Need to Fight (A Revelation of God's hosts – Armies and the Appropriate Role for the Church)
- A. We Are God's Children (Family), Not His Warriors (Army) – Ps. 81:13-16
 - B. God's Hosts are His Angelic Army and Messengers – Gen. 32:1,2
 - C. God's Armies Designed to Fight for God's People – Ex. 14:12,14; Ex. 23:27,31; Deut. 1: 29,30; Deut. 3:22; Deut. 20: 1-4; 1Chron. 17:20-30; 2Chron. 32:7,8
 - D. True Meaning of Ephesians 6:10-17 & 2Cor. 10:3,4
 - E. Revelation of the "Warped Bow" – Ps. 78: 8,22,41,56-57
6. Primary Reason for the Day of God's Glory Upon His People is The Great harvest of Souls
- A. God Stands Before A Door of Final Judgment with Long Patience to Gather the Precious Fruit of the Earth – James 5:7-9
 - B. World's Resources Prophetically Destined For Those Who Favor this Great Righteous Cause – Is. 23:18; Ps. 35:27; Prov. 13:22; Job 27:16,17; Ecc. 2:26;
7. An End-Times Generational Revelation of Alive and Remain – Special Keys to Divine Health and Life
- A. God Bids & is Faithful to His People for a Special Blessing of Preservation and Level of Life – 1Thes. 5:23,24;
 - B. The Generation of the Noon Day Sun – Proverbs 4:18; 1Thes. 5:5
 - C. Revelation from Glory to glory – 2 Cor. 3:18; Eph. 1:17-19

- D. God Reveals a Special Angel to Bless Food to Nourish our Physical Bodies & Take Sickness Out of our Midst – Ex. 23:20,25,26
- E. Psalmist David Called this Blessing One of the Divine Benefits from God to “Sate Our Mouths with Good Things So that Our Juvenility Might Be Restored – Ps. 103:5
- F. A Revelation of Life Prophesied by Psalmist David for a New Creation Generation Who Would be “Loosed From the Appointment of Death” – Ps. 102:18-20
- G. Revelation of “One Appointment to Die and One Appointment Kept = No Appointment Remaining” - Heb. 9:27,28 (“...as it is appointed unto men once to die... so Christ died once for all men.”) 2Tim. 1:10 (Death Abolished)
- H. Paul’s Goal Was to “Attain to His Resurrected Immortal Body” (Which Has Already Been Promised Every Believer at the Day of Resurrection) While He Yet Lived in His Present Flesh (Not that He Had a Testimony that He Had Attained to It, But that He Was Actively Believing for It in this Life) He Called it “the Mark of the High Calling in Christ – Philippians. 3:11-14
- I. A Generation that Will Be Alive & Remain Until the Coming of the Lord – 1Cor. 15:51; 1Thes. 4:15-17
